Security & Safety Team

Is a small but very important team. We will be employing some specialist professional Security Staff, but to give assistance for the whole site, including the main entrances and exits, we are looking for a team of people that will help make sure everyone is safe on the day. You will see that there is some specialisms so if you think you fit the bill please do apply.

Front of House Stewarding Team

Goes without saying that this team will make or break audience enjoyment. You will be warm and welcoming and you will be armed with all of the necessary information (running times, toilet locations, taxi numbers etc) to make the audience feel welcome.

Setup & Breakdown Team

Perhaps some of the heroes of the day, as the set-up team will need to be on site for 6.00am with the site needing to be ready by 9.00am. Then after the last performance, finishing around 4.45pm, the Breakdown Team working to get everything off the site and make sure all is as we found it. Stage Management team & Stage Crew

Is responsible for purchasing, acquiring, manufacturing, properly placing, and/or overseeing any props needed for a production.
